Assessment and Liaison Equipment
Wyndham, Broome, Karratha, Carnarvon
Geraldton, Fremantle, Albany, Esperance
Coverage area: within 300km of stockpile location
Mobilisation method: Drive/vessel any coastal location within 300km of stockpile location

Field Response Equipment – North West Karratha

Coverage Area: Kimberly, Pilbara and Mid-West-Gascoyne districts

D Mobilisation Method: Drive/tow any coastal location north of Carnarvon and west of Broome

F Mobilisation Method: Fly/freight any coastal location south of Carnarvon and east of Broome

Incident Management Equipment Fremantle

Coverage Area: Whole State

D Mobilisation Method: Drive/tow any coastal location south of Geraldton and west of Esperance

F Mobilisation Method: Fly/freight any coastal location north of Geraldton and east of Esperance

Field Response Equipment – South West Fremantle

Coverage Area: Mid-West-Gascoyne, Wheatbelt, Metropolitan, South-West, Great Southern and Goldfields-Esperance districts

D Mobilisation Method: Drive/tow any coastal location south of Geraldton and west of Esperance

F Mobilisation Method: Fly/freight any coastal location north of Geraldton and east of Esperance

Wildlife Response Equipment Fremantle

Coverage Area: Whole State

D Mobilisation Method: Drive/tow Field Equipment any coastal location south of Geraldton and west of Esperance

F Mobilisation Method: Freight Field Equipment any coastal location north of Geraldton and east of Esperance and freight primary care facilities any coastal location
